



- Construction is expected to begin in early 2012 and last for approximately 18 months.
- Brand Library & Art Center (including the art & music libraries, galleries, recital hall and Brand Studios) will be completely closed for the duration of the renovation.
- Portions of the Library collection will most likely be made available in a temporary location that has yet to be determined.
 - Which collections and services will be made available at the temporary location?
 - What programming (art, music & dance) will be made available at the temporary location?

Answers to these questions will be determined by library staff based on size and feasibility of the temporary location.
- Classes normally held at Brand Studios (operated by the Community Services & Parks Dept.) will be held in a temporary location(s) that has yet to be determined.

The information above will change and become more finalized as the project progresses.

Wayfinding: Unify entries to Library and Art Center/Recital Hall and clarify entry to Brand Studios

Safety: Protect public safety through seismic improvements to entire building including Library, Gallery, Recital Hall and Art Studios

Accessibility: Improve accessibility for people with disabilities through full compliance to the Americans with Disabilities Act

Required Seismic and Maintenance Upgrades: Structural, HVAC, electrical and life safety improvements
